Theological Point:

God’s plan for the future of Israel is true and the others he purifies, as well as those who remain impure and receive judgment, is determined to be completed in the 70th week of Daniel’s prophecy.

God will resurrect all those who have lived and deal with all accordingly. Those in the book of life will serve him in his glorious kingdom forever and the rest are resurrected to eternal judgment.

- **Recognizing historical accuracy of prophecy** – confidence in the truth of God’s Word
- **Allow End Times prophecy to cultivate your affections for God’s future plan**
 - Look forward to the end
 - Be faithful to understand
 - Share the message – look at 12:3
- **Overall perspective of Daniel – God is in perfect, sovereign control.**
