  - a) Collision of previous ideas:
    - i. Dreams, wise men, interpretations, Daniel...
  - b) Key repetitions?
    - i. Vs 9 "Spirit of God"
- 4.10b-18 Nebuchadnezzar's Dream
  - a) Vs 17-18 collision of multiple ideas:
    - i. "know" "rules the kingdom" "gives"
    - ii. "Spirit of God"
  - b) Youths answer
    - i. "We will not serve"
    - ii. "Our God is able"
