Background of Ezra

- Israelites desire a restoration of the theocratic <u>kingdom</u>:
 - o Need a <u>Davidic</u> King.
 - Need <u>Priesthood</u> (<u>Temple</u>).
 - Need to keep the Mosaic <u>Covenant</u>.
- "The good <u>hand</u> of our God is upon us."

(Ezra 7:6, 9, 28; 8:18, 22, 31)

Lesson 10 - Ezra 8

The <u>good</u> hand of God is upon Ezra and His people for their <u>good</u>!

- I. God's hand <u>provides</u> and answers prayer as Israel <u>prepares</u> to return (8:1-30).
 - A. Ezra lists the <u>volunteers</u> who returned with him (8:1-14).
 - B. Ezra realizes they have no <u>Levites</u> (8:15-20).

- C. Ezra chooses to trust the hand of God for their good, instead of his own <u>fearful</u> worries (8:21-23).
 [Nehemiah 2:7-9: Nehemiah trusts the Lord with His provision of a military escort]
- D. Ezra chooses 12 <u>leaders</u> of the priests to carry the <u>offerings</u> (8:24-30).
- II. God's hand guards Israel from enemy and ambush on the journey (8:31-36).
 - A. God <u>protected</u> His <u>people</u> and their funds (8:31-34).
 - B. First, the people offer <u>sacrifices</u> to their God (8:35).
 - C. Second, the people delivered the <u>king's</u> orders (8:36).

So What?

- We must humble ourselves before the <u>face</u> of our God to know the straight way for us and our little ones (8:21).
- God's good hand brings goodness to us (Romans 8:28).
- If God <u>wanted</u> us to have a military escort, we <u>would</u> (Nehemiah 2:7-9).
- We can have faith that the <u>path</u> God has us on is His good path. Follow Him in the moment-by-moment decisions of life, and you will be right where He wants you to be.
