		0	Subordination: Jesus is not now, nor ever has been ontologically ("in and of Himself") subordinate to the Father. This would be a denial of the trinity and divinity of Jesus.

0	Subordination: Jesus is functionally subordinate to the Father (Phil. 2:5-11). This does not mean inferiority or loss of deity, rather it refers to Jesus' willing submission to the Father in how they function.
