Preliminary Considerations

- “ _____ ”
 - refers to Jesus who is the “only _____” of the Father. This title denotes Jesus’ equal divine essence with the Father (John 5:18).
 - describes an eternal _____ within the Godhead (John 5:26).
- Trinitarian Ordering
 - _____ Subordination: Jesus is not now, nor ever has been ontologically (“in and of Himself”) subordinate to the Father. This would be a denial of the trinity and divinity of Jesus.

- _____ Subordination: Jesus is functionally subordinate to the Father (Phil. 2:5-11). This does not mean inferiority or loss of deity, rather it refers to Jesus' willing submission to the Father in how they function.
