

A Study of Ezra & Esther

Big Picture & Class Outline (Chronological Study)

- First Exile Expedition: Temple from Ruins (Ezra 1-6).
- Back in Persia: Everyone almost Dies (Esther).
- Second Exile Expedition: A Return to the Law (Ezra 7-10).

I. An Assassination Plot is Discovered (Esther 2:21-23)

- A. The plot formulated by <u>Bigthan</u> and <u>Teresh</u> to <u>assassinate</u> the king is over heard by Mordecai (v21)
- B. Mordecai informs <u>Esther</u> who in turn informs the <u>king</u> (v22)
- C. Bigthan and Teresh are <u>hung</u> for their <u>treachery</u> (v23)

II. An Agagite's Passion Disclosed (3:1-6)

- A. Haman's <u>Promotion</u>: He is placed above all other <u>officials</u> similar to the role of a <u>prime minister</u> (v1)
- B. Hamans' <u>Provocation</u>: The king commanded all servants in the king's gate to pay <u>homage</u> to Haman (v2a)
 - Mordecai refuses to bow, saying it was simply because he was a <u>Jew</u> (v2b-4)
- C. Haman's <u>Purpose</u>: Not content with seeking retribution with <u>Mordecai</u> alone, he sets his sights on all <u>Jews</u>. (v5-6)

III. An Annihilation Plan is Decreed (Esther 3:7-15)

- A. The <u>casting</u> of lots: Haman uses the casting of <u>Pur</u>, a form of lots, to determine the date approximately a year later (13th day of the twelfth moon) (v7)
- B. The <u>command</u> of the king: Haman informs the king of a "<u>certain people</u>" who are refusing to obey the king's laws (v8)

- Haman <u>reveals</u> his plan to <u>destroy</u> the "people" who do not follow the king's laws with his own money! (v9)
- 2. The king <u>approves</u> Haman's plan and gives him his <u>signet ring</u> and funds the project (v10-11)
- The <u>edict</u> is spread throughout the land of Persia (v12-14)

C. The confusion in the land (3:15)

- 1. The edict <u>spreads</u>, and so does <u>confusion</u>
- 2. The king <u>drinks</u> while the kingdom falls into <u>shock</u>

So What?

- God is sovereign over <u>all</u> things
 - Sovereign over <u>time</u>
 - Everything happens on God's timetable
 - o sovereign over <u>events</u>
 - All things that happen are allowed to happen according to God's will
 - o sovereign over our <u>suffering</u>
 - God allows earthly suffering to bring us heavenly gain
