What is Evangelism?

"Teaching the gospel with the aim to persuade."

- J. Mack Stiles, Evangelism.
 - 1. Evangelism must involve <u>teaching</u> words and explanation. Jesus' primary ministry was <u>teaching</u> (Mark 1:14-15; Romans 10:17).
 - Evangelism requires the message of the gospel (Romans 1:16).
 Essential Gospel: Jesus died for our sins and rose again.
 Message: (1) Bad News, (2) Good News, (3) Choice.
 - Evangelism has a clear <u>aim</u>. This implies <u>motivation</u> (2 Corinthians 5:14-16), and a <u>target</u>.
 - 4. Evangelism intends to persuade (2 Corinthians 5:20).
 - Consider the need (John 3:36).
 - Consider the cost (2 Corinthians 5:15, 17; Mark 8:34).
 - Consider the urgency (Luke 12:20).
 - Consider the benefit (2 Cor. 5:19-21; John 10:10).

What Evangelism is *Not*:

- Imposition You are not forcing your opinion on someone, you are sharing the truth, which may be offensive.
- Sharing your Testimony This may be a helpful *part* of evangelism, but it doesn't point to *their* need for salvation.
- Social Action/Public Involvement/Events The gospel must be clearly communicated and promoted. Events are not evangelism.
- Apologetics It is good to answer questions but make a beeline to Jesus!
- The *results* of Evangelism We cannot make anyone believe the gospel; God's Spirit must convert the person.
