### **Big Picture & Class Outline (Chronological Study)**

- First Exile Expedition: Temple from Ruins (Ezra 1-6).
- Back in Persia: Everyone almost Dies (Esther).
- Second Exile Expedition: A Return to the Law (Ezra 7-10).

#### Lesson 7 – Esther 6:1-7:10

- 6. God <u>resists</u> the <u>proud</u> (6-7).
  - Haman goes to <u>court</u> to ask for <u>permission</u> to put Mordecai to <u>death</u> (6:1-13).
    - i. On a <u>random</u> night, the king could not <u>sleep</u> and wanted to be read to (6:1).
    - ii. The king finds that Mordecai has not been honored(2-3).
    - iii. Haman is selected to <u>honor</u> Mordecai instead of <u>executing</u> him (4-13).
  - b. Haman is taken to "court" (6:14-7:4).
    - i. Haman is <u>escorted</u> to the <u>banquet</u> (6:14-7:1).
    - ii. Esther reveals she has an enemy (7:2-7:4).
  - c. Haman is the <u>object</u> of the king's <u>wrath</u> (7:5-8).

d. Haman receives the <u>death</u> he <u>planned</u> for Mordecai (7:9-10).

#### So What?

- God can do whatever He wants whenever He wants.
- Reminds me of the gospel.
- God is not an absent-minded ruler (Matthew 6:25-34).
- God <u>resists</u> the proud but gives <u>grace</u> to the humble (James 4:6).
- Meditate on <u>Jesus</u>, not our own desires and <u>honor</u>
  (Colossians 3:1-2).
