Lesson 8 – Esther 8-10

- 7. God's people begin to triumph over the house of their enemy (8:1-2).
- 8. God delivers His people Israel from their evil enemies (8:3-14).
 - Esther <u>begs</u> the king to stop the <u>evil</u> that is coming to her people (8:3-6).
 - The king grants permission for the Jews to <u>fight</u> back against their <u>enemies</u> (8:7-14).
- 9. God allows His people to <u>rejoice</u> over their <u>enemies</u> (8:15-9:4).
 - a. The <u>Jewish</u> people are <u>exalted</u> (8:15-17).
 - b. The <u>Jewish</u> people overpowered those who <u>hated</u> them (9:1-4).

- 10. The Jewish people <u>slaughtered</u> their enemies but did not <u>plunder</u> them (9:5-19).
- 11. The <u>decree</u> of Esther for the holiday of <u>Purim</u> was announced in two letters (9:20-32).
- 12. Mordecai sought the <u>good</u> of his people in <u>Haman's</u> position of second in the kingdom (10).

So What?

- Our <u>sorrow</u> will be turned to <u>joy</u> which no one can take away from us. The <u>best</u> is still to come (John 16:16-24;
 Revelation 21:4).
- Nothing is <u>random</u>. "The <u>lot</u> is cast into the lap, but its every decision is from the LORD" (Proverbs 16:33).
- <u>Jesus</u> is the only one who will bring real <u>peace</u> (Zechariah 9:10).
- Hope in the Lord, not in men or yourself.
