Class 6 – A New Paradigm: Loving and Serving instead of Fearing and Needing.

1. A reorientation toward God: perfect love casts out fear (1 John 4:7-5:3).

Notice what we learn about God's love:

- 1. God is <u>love</u> (7, 8, 16).
- 2. God loved us <u>first</u> (9, 10, 11, 19).
- 3. God <u>showed</u> His love by sending His Son to be our Savior (9, 10, 14, 5:1).
- 4. God's perfect <u>love</u> casts out <u>fear</u> (17-18).
- 5. The first response to God's love is to love <u>Him</u> in return (16, 19, 5:1-2).
- 6. The second response to God's love is to love <u>others</u>.

2. Reorientation to other people: loving and serving, not fearing and needing.

Notice the ways 1 John 4:7-5:3 shows the importance of loving others in response to God's love for us:

- 1. God's love *motivates* us to love others (7, 11, 19).
- 2. God's love fully <u>equips</u> us to show His love to others (12-16).
- 3. God's love <u>commands</u> us to love others (4:20-5:3).

Whom do we need to love and serve?

<u>God</u> (Matthew 22:37-38)

<u>Enemies</u> (Luke 6:27-33)

Unbelievers

Neighbors (Matthew 22:39)

Our physical <u>families</u>

Brothers and Sisters (Galatians 6:10)

What shape does this loving and serving take?

Developing a true servant's heart—How do we carry out a heart of love? What does it look like to love instead of fear and need?

- 1. Consider your <u>motivation</u> even when it comes to loving and serving others.
- 2. Look to <u>Jesus</u>.
- 3. <u>Pray</u> regularly for other people.
- 4. Think about how you can <u>minister</u> to others in specific ways.

Results of loving and serving rather than fearing and needing <u>Unity</u>

Genuine <u>respect</u> and <u>appreciation</u> of others

Peace, joy, longsuffering, gentleness—the <u>fruit</u> of the Spirit

Conclusion

When you are gripped by fear of man, look up to the Lord and remember his power and love. His perfect love casts out your fear. In His love you are accepted, protected, and justified.
