Class 8 – Remember God's Sovereignty in Decision-Making

Introduction

God is Sovereign

<u>All things</u> are under God's rule and control. Nothing happens without His <u>direction</u> or <u>permission</u>. God works not just some things but all things according to the counsel of His own will.

Let's notice some aspects of God's sovereignty:

- 1. God is sovereign over our <u>circumstances</u> (Genesis 50:20).
- 2. God is sovereign over our <u>past</u> and our <u>future</u> (Isaiah 46:10).
- 3. God is sovereign over our <u>decisions</u> (Psalm 33:10-11).
- 4. God is sovereign even over our <u>hearts</u> (Proverbs 21:1).

God's Goal is to Glorify Himself Notice some examples from Scripture:

- 1. He made <u>people</u> for His glory (Isaiah 43:7).
- 2. He rescued Israel from Eqypt for His glory (Exodus 9:16).
- 3. He rescued Israel from <u>Babylon</u> for His glory (Ezekiel 36:22).
- 4. He <u>sent</u> Jesus to earth for His glory (John 1:14).
- 5. He <u>saved</u> us for His glory (Ephesians 1:11).
- 6. Jesus is coming <u>back</u> for His glory.

Man's Responsibility in Decision-Making

We are responsible for our <u>actions</u> (Matthew 12:36-37).

We are responsible to <u>glorify</u> God (1 Corinthians 10:31).

Motivated by Faithfulness

We are to be <u>faithful</u> as stewards of what God has given us.

We are not motivated by <u>results</u>.

Motivated by Meaning

God's sovereignty gives meaning to our decisions in two ways:

- 1. Meaning for <u>what</u> we do.
- 2. Meaning for <u>how</u> we do what we do.

How does God's sovereignty give meaning?

- 1. God gives meaning to the <u>mundane</u> (Matthew 10:29-31).
- 2. God gives meaning to all of our <u>relationships</u> (Acts 17:26-27).
- 3. God gives meaning to our work (Ephesians 6:5-7).

Conclusion: Restful Decision-Making

As we grow in our reverence for God's sovereignty and goodness, we will not live in fear of ruining God's will or thwarting His purposes. Instead, we will want to be faithful to Him as a good steward of His resources. We will seek to make decisions that glorify Him and move forward with restful confidence in His sovereignty.
