Class 10 – Pursuing Faithfulness

Introduction

1. What is faithfulness?

Faithfulness is <u>living</u> to <u>please</u> the <u>Lord</u>.

What are some examples of things the Bible says are God's will for our lives?

God wants you to be like <u>Jesus</u> (Ephesians 4:12-15, 20-24; Colossians 1:28; 1 Peter 2:21).

Jesus lived to please the Father (John 8:28-29).

2. How can we live faithful lives?

God works in you so you can please Him (Philippian 2:1-13).

1. It matters <u>what</u> we do.

- 2. It matters *how* we do it.
- 3. It matters <u>why</u> we do it.

If you know what God wants you to do, but you don't want to do it, what should you do?

3. What do faithful decisions look like?

Faithful decisions - decisions that please Him, will have these marks:

1) Focus: The <u>revelation</u> of Jesus Christ (1 Peter 1:6-8; 2 Corinthians 5:10; Matthew 25:21).

2) Goal: <u>Glorify</u> God – Please Him (1 Corinthians 10:31; 2 Corinthians 5:9).

3) Extent: All of life (Romans 12:1).

4. Faithfulness Brings Freedom and Protection

	Outcome-focused	Faithfulness-focused
Whom do we trust?	Ourselves	God
Who gets credit?	Ourselves	God
Success is	Seen by people	Seen by God

Freedoms and protections that come from faithful decisions:

- 1. Freedom from perfectionism.
- 2. Freedom from <u>regret</u>.
- 3. Freedom from pride.
- 4. Protection from <u>burnout</u> (Mark 6:30-32; Ephesians 2:10).
- 5. Protection from people-pleasing (Matthew 12:46-50; John 6:15).
- Protection from <u>wastefulness</u> (Luke 12:13-21; 1 Corinthians 3:11-15).
- 5. Faithfulness brings responsibility

Conclusion

The goal of our decision-making is faithfulness – living to please the Lord.
